NAKED ICONOCLASTS FIGHTING THE YOKE

Meeting called to order.

(1) Korky mentioned revisions to previous minutes (of April 10, 1994 meeting):
- What he actually had said regarding last names was that we should assign last names for the purpose of the minutes, even if they are psuedonyms.
- Paragraphs should be numbered.
- 7th paragraph: Substitute "nonsexual" for "clean".
- References should be to Wreck Beach Swim Club as opposed to WBPS.
MOTION (Marilyn) Accept minutes. Passed.

(2) Marilyn announced a protest against Mead-Johnson to be held the next day.

(3) OLD BUSINESS. Marilyn said to make sure we are all paid up.
MOTION (Marilyn) Set minimum membership fee of \$1. Second: Deb. Withdrawn.

(4) MOTION (Marilyn) If Rick hasn't written letter to WBSC as arranged in meeting of April 10, we resolve to do that now. Second: Deb. Passed.
Greg will try to find insurance rates, whether they apply for a calendar year or a full year, and the earliest available time from 18:00 onward, last Saturday of month.

Motion (Korky) Procure loans from the people here to fund insurance.

Don offered to donate \$200.

Proposed: Swims last Saturday of each month, year round, 2 hours, as early as possible after last use of pool.

MOTION (Greg) Price should be \$4.50, 4 for members. Second: Marilyn. Passed.
Swims will be clothing optional.

(5) Greg and Deb will write a letter to the Civil Liberties Association.

(6) Regarding the Dionysius benefit concert for NIFTY, we resolved that it was to be alcohol-free, and should be billed as a family-oriented event. Terry said he will look into it. We made a list of possible places.

(7) Marilyn read her letter which was accepted.

(8) We considered a possible future event: Announce a public debate, and invite Preston Manning or someone to come discuss the merits of the anti-nudity law. We could invite someone from the audience if celebrity guest does not show. Get the media interested by sending out a press release.

(9) Greg will write a letter to Riley Park community centre regarding their refusal to distribute Allies. It will mention that they are eliminating all the allies, including advocates of breastfeeding, organic food, and cooperatives. You wouldn't ban a magazine because you didn't like one article. Point out ads showing nudity in Georgia Straight, etc., and that it is healthy and wholesome. Phrease as a question: Are you under the impression that we are promoting nudity?

(10) Accept proposals for T-shirt designs and wording at next meeting.

(11) We will put in a new Allies section as soon as we have some cash. Marilyn reiterated that we should try to solicit more advertisers.

(12) Next meeting set for December 20, 1994, 19:30.
