Minutes of NIFTY meeting #10, 1998 March 11 Location: Firehall Library meeting room, Vancouver

Korky acclaimed chair.

- 1. Marilyn: Accept minutes of meeting #9 as written. s. Greg. PASSED
- 2. Greg gave report. Accepted.
- 3. Marilyn: try to get more people for swim nights; price should be raised; reduce length to two hours. Greg objected to any increase in price. Steve noted that North Van charges \$4.50, and we have the volunteer option too.

MOTION (Doug, s. Steve) that we strike a committee consisting of Marilyn, Greg and Korky to adjust the finances of the swims, to continue running generally until next meeting. PASSED with one nay vote.

- Steve to post swim info on internet.

- 4. Marilyn: Signs regarding respect for others should be posted and obvious at NIFTY swims. Doug suggested they should be inside the change rooms. This was accepted.
- MOTION (Greg, s. Doug) We should not allow leaflets, etc. for discriminatory (i.e., men only, etc.) events to be distributed at the NIFTY swim sign-in table, as people might associate such events with NIFTY which is an egalitarian group. Motion failed.
- 5. MOTION (Marilyn, s. Elizabeth) that we write something up to give out regarding the nude vs. clothing-optional debate, to allay people's concerns about potential repercussions and alleged disadvantages of clothing-optional events. PASSED. Marilyn will write a draft.
- MOTION (Marilyn, s. Doug) that NIFTY donate \$25 to the Wreck Beach Preservation Society (WBPS).WITHDRAWN

MOTION (Marilyn, s. Elizabeth) that we have a donation box for WBPS at sign-in table for NIFTY swims. WITHDRAWN

- 7. MOTION (Greg, s. Marilyn) that we buy some tarps. AMENDMENT (Doug) add "or used sheets, or whatever's cheap, with a budget of up to \$25". AMENDED MOTION PASSED
- 8. Brainstorming: How to attract more females? suggestions: word of mouth Elizabeth said she had some H&E articles that might help, she will bring to next swim.
- 9. Newsletter: Korky said we should try instead to get articles in other papers, as a NIFTY newsletter would be too expensive. Roy suggested Shared Vision. Greg will contact that publication.
- 10. MOTION (Greg, s. Doug) that we draft a petition calling for the repeal of Canada Criminal Code section 172, and circulate it on behalf of NIFTY. PASSED with 1 abstention.

MOTION (Greg, s. Marilyn) to adjourn meeting. PASSED
