

Minutes of NIFTY meeting #11,2000 May 10, Firehall library meeting room, Vancouver, 19:00 - 20:45 Present at opening of meeting: Korky, Marilyn, Gerhardt Schulz, Ian Jarvis, Greg

- 1. Call to order
- 2. Marilyn appointed chair.
- 3. MOTION (Korky) s. Greg. Accept minutes of meeting #10 as written. PASSED
- 4. Dance: Discussion on hiring Flying Folk Army; cost seemed prohibitive. Korky suggested we bargain with them; request only some of the band members perform, etc.

MOTION (Marilyn) s. Greg. We approach Flying Folk Army with \$450 and percentage eciling, or else approach "Wreek Beach Co-op" and other bands.

AMENDMENT (Korky) Ask if they will play for \$300 plus percentage initially. Korky & Greg will negotiate. PASSED unanimously

5. Greg proposed a NIFTY newsletter. Ian suggested using 100% recycled, unbleached paper. Marilyn suggested the newsletter encourage its readers to join or donate. Korky proposed that Korky, Greg & Marilyn form an editorial committee. Marilyn said we should accept advertising from progressive groups. Ian named the Van Tan club. MOTION (Korky) s. Ian That we strike a committee to draft a NIFTY newsletter, print however many copies we can get for up to \$100. Korky, Marilyn & Greg to be on committee. Allow ads from progressive groups. Try to get 100% recycled, unbleached

paper. PASSED unanimously.

- 6. Greg mentioned that NATURALLY magazine had offered us a free subscription as long as we sent them copies of our member communications. This presents another motivation for getting a newsletter together.
- 7. Greg proposed some demonstrations. Marilyn said it was a bad idea unless people came out. Korky wondered how we could attract enthusiasm and media attention, and proposed a 'million moon march'. MOTION (Korky) That we stage a million moon march, directed possibly at some public official, combined with a topfree march, ending with a picnic, this summer. FAILED for lack of second MOTION (Marilyn) s. Korky Mention in the newsletter that we want to do an outdoor public event, but need commitment of participants. Put out a blurb at a dance. PASSED unanimously

Sticker campaign: MOTION (Korky) that we budget \$10 for stickers, solicit designs, and collect donations. WITHDRAWN MOTION (Marilyn) s. Greg That we come up with designs for the next NIFTY meeting. PASSED unanimously

\*Note: At this point agenda items 8-10 were deleted from agenda, due to time constraints, by consensus.

11. Some discussion around relations between NIFTY and the Wreck Beach Swim Club.

MOTION (Marilyn) s. Korky People putting on any kind of nudist actions, topfree events, events at Wreck Beach, etc. that are not NIFTY endorsed, should not mention that they are a part of NIFTY, PASSED with 1 abstention. MOTION (Korky) s. Ian That we offer 2 free dance tickets to other groups. PASSED unanimously

12. Discussion on second swims each month

MOTION (Greg) s. Gerhardt That NIFTY, starting in September of 2000, have swim/sauna nights on the second and last Saturday of each month, but not conflicting with any other groups' nude-friendly activities. Attempt to get Bonsor, Percy Norman, or some other pool. PASSED unanimously

- 13. Picnics/Camping: TABLED until next meeting
- 14. MOTION (Marilyn) s. Ian That we authorize Greg to put any approved NIFTY literature and links to other nude-friendly groups and coming events, excluding last names except where authorized, on the proposed NIFTY website. PASSED unanimously
- 15. Other business

PETITION: MOTION (Greg) s. Marilyn That we solicit feedback from membership with intent to finalize and begin circulation of petition. PASSED

SWIM TIMES: MOTION (Korky) s. Ian That we have (A) 2.5 hours per swim starting in September, reverting back to 2 hours if we lose money, and (B) try a social on the last Saturday of September, for 1 - 3 hours, depending on the band. (A) WITHDRAWN, (B) CARRIED with I abstention.

MOTION (Marilyn) s. Greg At the next swim, we question people: would you pay more for a 2.5 hour swim? CARRIED with I abstention. Marilyn will take this on.
